"We would like to have pedestrian access from the Park, through the site, connecting other green spaces and roads, like a green corridor through the site"

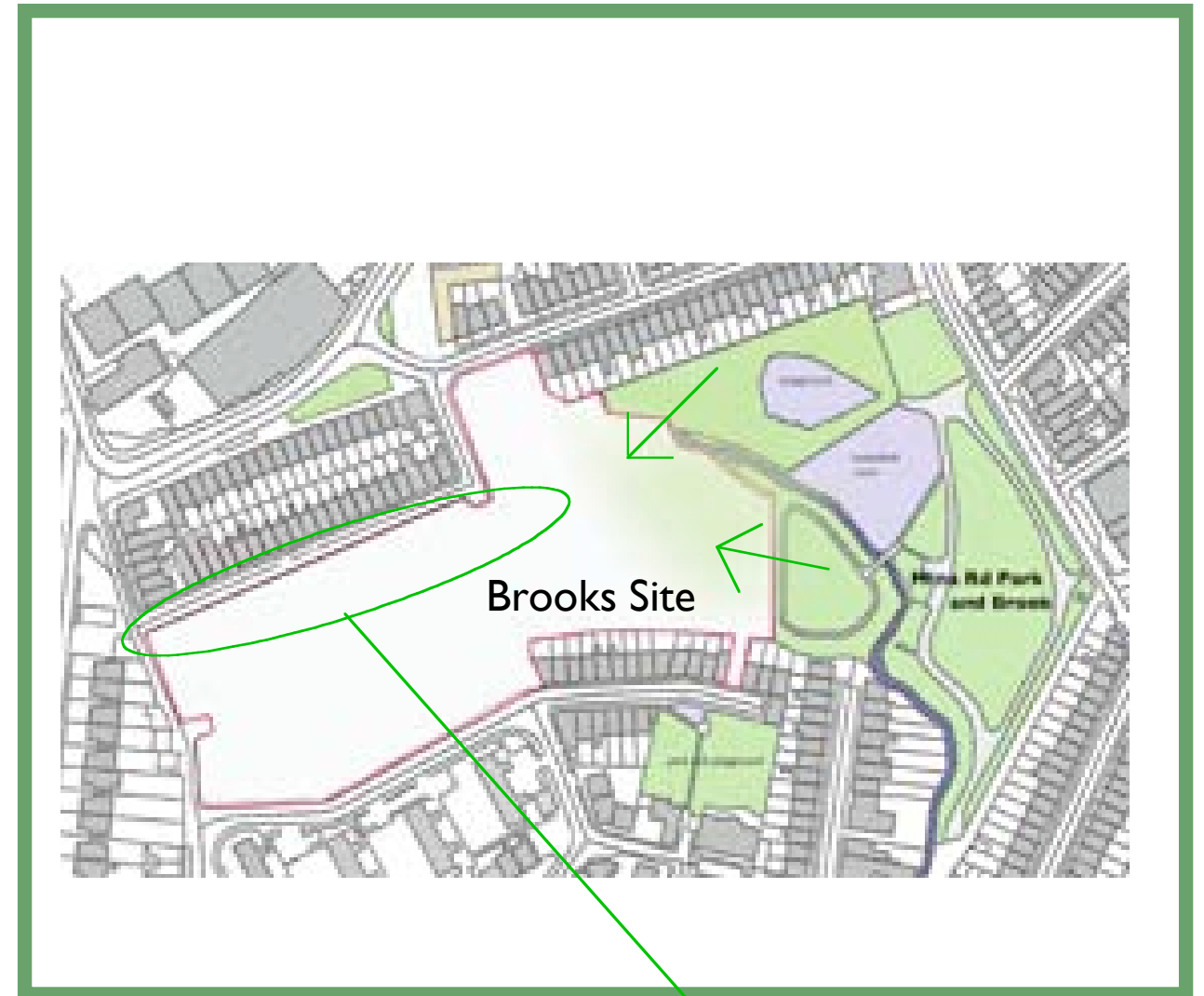
